LEST WE FORGET

I would like to start off with acknowledging the people who have passed away who were South African Whistleblowers:

1. Barbita Deokaran (53), Gauteng Health Dept Official – gunned down outside her home on 23 August 2021.
2. Lennox Garane (57)– Parliamentary Official – Protest suicide on 14 September 2018 (Protest against bullying by Dumisane Sithole and the then Speaker Baleka Mbete and the then Chairperson Thandi Modise – did nothing)
3. Sikhosiphi (Bazooka) Radebe (51) was the Chairperson of the Amadiba Crisis Committee – an organisation campaigning against mining in Xolobeni, in the Pondoland region of the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa. Gunned down outside his home in Lurholweni township in Mbizana, Eastern Cape
4. Jimmy Mohlala, Speaker of the Mbombela Municipality, whistleblower – was shot dead in his Nelspruit home in Jan 2009, by two masked men. He blew the whistle on Mbombela Municipal Manager Jacob Dladla. (R1600 million / Pounds 80 million). He uncovered a fraudulent Tax Certificate was used to secure a tender for the stadium.
5. Philemon Ngwenya (53) of Thembalihle near Vrede – murdered. He was outspoken about the dubious farm deal. Estina Dairy Farm. He had been stabbed with a sharp object. His body was brutally battered.
6. Moses Tshake – an auditor in the Free State Dept of Agriculture. He was kidnapped, tortured and killed after he questioned payments linked to the controversial farm project in 2013.
7. Moss Phokoe, Rustenburg Councillor, was shot dead at his home in Rustenburg North in March 2009 after handing over a dossier detailing corruption in the Bojanala District Municipality.
8. Barbita Deokaran gunned down outside her home on 23 August 2021. She gave evidence to the SIU regarding the Protective Equipment spending - Gauteng Health Department.
9. Marumo Eric Phenya - Reported on corruption on a multi-million Home Affairs tender. He was gunned down near his home in the West Rand – last week in Oct 2022.

Whistleblowers who are in hiding:

1. Athol Williams – Bain whistleblower – fled South Africa, for fear of his life.
2. Sinethemba Mbuli – Whistleblower from Kingdom Prayer Ministry Soweto. Atrocities done by the pastor at the church. Living in hiding.
3. Thabiso Zulu – Harry Gwala Municipality. Attempts made on his life. He is in hiding at present. He cannot see his own children.
4. Nonhle Mbuthuma – Amadiba Crises Committee – Eastern Cape Wild Coast area - Pondoland -Australian Company partnered with Government to mine titanium. The community refused. Attempts on her life has been made. She lives in hiding.
5. Aristeidas Danikas – Previous SAPS Reservist – whistle blew on atrocities committed by the Cato Manor SAPS – had to leave South Africa.
6. Patricia Mashale - SAPS - Reporting corrupting in the Police Force. She is being victimised. She still speaks out constantly. Living in hiding.
